- _____ Sleeping bag. Zero degree or better recommended for winter trips.
- _____ Sleeping pad (self inflating or closed cell foam)
- _____ Baseball cap
- _____ Waterproof/breathable rain jacket (rain pants optional)
- _____ Waterproof boots
- _____ Sneakers
- _____ 3 pairs of socks. Wool or synthetic fabrics preferred over cotton.
- _____ 1 spare change of clothes
- _____ Fleece pullover or jacket
- _____ Sweats to sleep in
- _____ Small flashlight or headlamp. Spare batteries.
- _____ Reusable water bottle
- _____ Scout Handbook
- _____ Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant
- _____ Sunblock and/or bug spray

- _____ Required medication. In plastic baggie with scout's name and dosage instructions.
- _____ Large duffel bag to put all your gear in. Duffel bag can be used as a pillow.
- _____ Collapsible chair

Cold Weather Trips Add:

- _____ Additional clothing layers. Synthetic base layer to wick moisture away from your body, insulating layer(s) to keep you warm, outer (waterproof) layer to keep you dry from rain or melting snow.
- _____ Winter coat, wool/fleece hat, gloves/mittens
- _____ Winter boots
- _____ Extra nalgene water bottle
- _____ Extra ground pad, foam mat, or blanket for UNDER your sleeping bag.
- _____ Hand warmers (optional)

- _____ Tent (or share with another dad)
