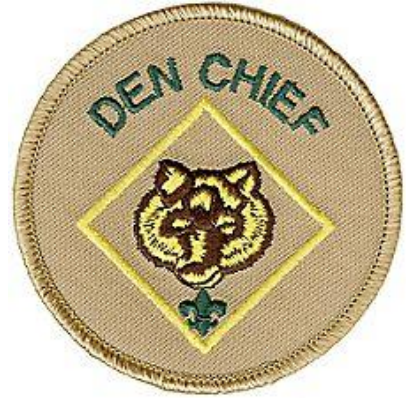


Den Chief

Age Requirements: 14+

Rank Requirements: First Class scout or above

Experience: Should have earned Arrow of Light.



General Leadership Responsibilities

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirt tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.

Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.

Attendance: Regularly attends troop meetings, campouts, and events during his service period.

Specific Job Responsibilities

- Attend council Den Chief Training
- Purchase and utilize Den Chief Handbook
- Meet regularly with the Den Leader to review the den and pack meeting plans.
- Help the Den Leader conduct various aspects of the den meetings such as running activities, games, and ceremonies. Must attend at least one Webelos meeting/activity per month during your service as a Den Chief.
- Helps Cub Scouts advance through Cub Scout ranks
- If serving as a Webelos Den Chief, prepare boys to join Boy Scouting by working on the Arrow of Light requirements.
- Know the purposes of Cub Scouting.
- Be a friend of the boys in the den.
- Attempt to earn the Den Chief Service Award. Note: A Scout that earns this award may wear the red, white and blue Den Chief Service Award cord as long as he is a Scout.
- Assist Webelos when they visit troop meetings and camping trips.
